The Petition of Samson Striker most humbly sheweth that your Excellency's Petitioner has drawn 200 acres of land at the East Side of the Little Lake and has improved thereon begs that his Lordship's bounty of two hundred acres may be granted to him agreeable to the Instruction of 1787 and as in duty bound will ever pray.
